"AN ACT CONCERNING TRANSPARENCY IN EDUCATION."

- After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and internal references accordingly:
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- 3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (e) of section 10-220 of the general statutes is
- 4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1*,
- 5 2023):
- 6 (e) (1) Each local and regional board of education shall establish a
- 7 school district curriculum committee. The committee shall recommend.
- 8 develop, review and approve all curriculum for the local or regional
- 9 school district, provided, prior to the approval of any curriculum for the
- 10 school district, such committee shall allow for a period of public
- 11 comment at all regular and special meetings of the local or regional
- 12 board of education.
- 13 (2) For the school year commencing July 1, 2023, and each school year

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thereafter, each local and regional board of education shall make 14 15 available on the board's and each individual school's Internet web site 16 the (A) syllabus and curriculum, including any accompanying materials related to implementing such curriculum, for each course offered by 17 18 such board or classroom at the school, and (B) the contact information 19 for a representative of the school district curriculum committee, 20 described in subdivision (1) of this subsection, who is responsible for making available to the parent or guardian of a student enrolled in a 21 school under the jurisdiction of such board who requests, any 22 23 curriculum materials that are unable to be published on such Internet 24 web site."
