"AN ACT CONCERNING TRANSPARENCY IN EDUCATION."

- Strike sections 2 and 3 in their entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:
- 3 "Sec. 2. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2023) On and after July 1, 2023, the
- 4 Department of Education shall annually offer a training program to
- 5 newly elected members of local and regional boards of education. Such
- 6 training program shall be developed by the department and include, but
- 7 not be limited to, the role and responsibilities of a board member, the
- 8 duties and obligations of a board of education and school district
- 9 budgeting and education finance. The department shall offer such
- training through means of a prerecorded video or through an on-line
- 11 platform. The department may collaborate with an association that
- 12 represents boards of education in the state, and accept gifts, grants and
- donations, including in-kind donations, to implement the provisions of
- 14 this section.

sSB 1 Amendment

Sec. 3. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2023*) On and after July 1, 2023, any person who has been elected to a local or regional board of education for the first time may complete, at a time and in a manner prescribed by the Department of Education, the training program for newly elected members of local and regional boards of education, as described in section 2 of this act. Each such member shall complete such training program not later than one year after assuming office."
