9 1002.32 Developmental research (laboratory) schools.—

10 (4) STUDENT ADMISSIONS.—Each lab school may establish a
11 primary research objective related to fundamental issues and
12 problems that occur in the public elementary and secondary
13 schools of the state. Admissions criteria should reflect an
14 emphasis on student merit and achievement with no regard to
15 race, sex, creed, color, or national origin. Lab schools may not
16 use racial or sex set-asides, preferences, or quotas in their
