## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Great Promise Partnership; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, an educated and well-trained work force is essential to the creation of a climate  
3 of success for Georgia's families, businesses, and communities; and

4 WHEREAS, Georgia's students sometimes face multiple obstacles in their goal to graduate  
5 from high school, which is necessary in order to attend college, join the military, or have the  
6 skills for full-time, well-paid employment; and

7 WHEREAS, education is Georgia's number one economic development tool, and Georgia's  
8 children are the next generation of this state's leaders, making it a priority for each citizen to  
9 prepare them to start businesses, launch successful careers, bring creative ideas to life, and  
10 pursue their dreams; and

11 WHEREAS, the success of this initiative or any initiative for Georgia's youth is contingent  
12 to a large degree on a partnership between this state's political, business, educational, and  
13 community leaders, the four cornerstones of Great Promise Partnership success, to help these  
14 young people become productive citizens and participants in the American Dream.

16 recognize and commend Great Promise Partnership for its contributions to the State of  
17 Georgia.
