## AN ACT

RELATING TO CONCEALED WEAPONS; AMENDING SECTION 18-3302C, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE A PROVISION REGARDING PROHIBITED CONDUCT AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. That Section 18-3302C, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
8 amended to read as follows:

9           18-3302C. PROHIBITED CONDUCT. (1) Any person obtaining a license un-  
10      der the provisions of section 18-3302, Idaho Code, or carrying a concealed  
11      deadly weapon pursuant to the provisions of section 18-3302(4)(f), Idaho  
12      Code, shall not:

(1) (a) Carry a concealed weapon in the courtroom portions of a court-house or in any area of a courthouse being used as a jail or holding facility for the detention of prisoners or any person undergoing trial or awaiting sentencing; in a juvenile detention facility or jail; or in a public or private school, except as provided in subsection (4)(g) of section 18-3302D, Idaho Code; provided that this subsection shall not apply to:

(a) (i) Peace officers while acting within the scope of their employment;

(b) (i) Security personnel while actually engaged in their employment; or

(e) (iii) Any person who is authorized to carry a weapon by a person, board, or other entity having authority over the building or facility; or

42) (b) Provide information on the application for a permit to carry a concealed weapon knowing the same to be untrue.

29                   (2) Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty  
30                   of a misdemeanor.

31 SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby  
32 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after  
33 July 1, 2026.
