



1           1. Measures or factors that could improve operating cost efficiencies  
2 after federal public lands are transferred to state control.

3           2. Options for funding land management activities, including control  
4 of forest fires and wildland fires.

5           3. Estimated asset value and sustained yield capacity associated with  
6 existing resources appurtenant to the land.

7           4. The degree to which federal Payment in Lieu of Taxes (PILT) and Se-  
8 cure Rural Schools (SRS) payments to counties may be continued, replicated  
9 or replaced.

10          5. Projected management costs and revenues under current and improved  
11 conditions.

12          6. A formula for distribution of revenues if revenues exceed operating  
13 costs.

14          7. A process to identify safeguards to protect or enhance public owner-  
15 ship, access, use, valid existing rights, land-based livelihoods, conserva-  
16 tion and economic production.

17          8. A process to identify criteria for priorities to determine which  
18 lands should, if any, be sought and in what sequence and time frame, includ-  
19 ing options for incremental acquisition.

20          9. A process to identify prospective pilot projects.

21          10. A process to identify entities that may be best suited to carry out  
22 pertinent management functions.

23          BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that nonlegislative members of the committee may  
24 be appointed by the cochairs of the committee who are appointed by the Leg-  
25 islative Council. Nonlegislative members of the advisory committee shall  
26 not be reimbursed from legislative funds for per diem, mileage or other ex-  
27 penses and shall not have voting privileges regarding the committee's recom-  
28 mendations or proposed legislation.

29          BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee shall issue a progress report  
30 to the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-third Idaho Legislature and shall  
31 report its findings, recommendations and proposed legislation, if any, to  
32 the First Regular Session of the Sixty-fourth Idaho Legislature.
