DIGEST OF SB 344 (Updated March 22, 2017 3:45 pm - DI 84)

Citations Affected: IC 35-47.

Synopsis: Possession of a firearm by an illegal alien. Provides that an alien who is illegally or unlawfully present in the United States and knowingly or intentionally possesses a firearm commits unlawful possession of a firearm by an alien, a Level 6 felony.

Effective: July 1, 2017.

ENGROSSED SENATE BILL No. 344

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning criminal law and procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 35-47-4-8 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2017]: **Sec. 8. (a) As used in this section, "alien" has the meaning**
4 **set forth in 8 U.S.C. 1101(a).**
5 **(b) Except as provided in subsection (c), an alien who:**
6 **(1) is illegally or unlawfully present in the United States; and**
7 **(2) knowingly or intentionally possesses a firearm;**
8 **commits unlawful possession of a firearm by an alien, a Level 6**
9 **felony.**
10 **(c) This section does not apply to an alien described in 18 U.S.C.**
11 **922(y)(2).**
