

**Senate Substitute for HOUSE BILL No. 2182**

1 AN ACT concerning crimes, punishment and criminal procedure; relating  
2 to the Kansas racketeer influenced and corrupt organization act;  
3 amending K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 21-6328 and 21-6329 and repealing the  
4 existing sections.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 21-6328 is hereby amended to read as  
8 follows: 21-6328. As used in the Kansas racketeer influenced and corrupt  
9 organization act:

10 (a) "Beneficial interest" means:

11 (1) The interest of a person as a beneficiary under any trust  
12 arrangement pursuant to which a trustee holds legal or record title to real  
13 property for the benefit of such person; or

14 (2) the interest of a person under any other form of express fiduciary  
15 arrangement pursuant to which any other person holds legal or record title  
16 to real property for the benefit of such person.

17 The term "beneficial interest" does not include the interest of a stock  
18 holder in a corporation or the interest of a partner in either a general  
19 partnership or a limited partnership. A beneficial interest shall be deemed  
20 to be located where the real property owned by the trustee is located.

21 (b) "Covered person" means any person who:

22 (1) Is a criminal street gang member or criminal street gang associate,  
23 as defined in K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 21-6313, and amendments thereto;

24 (2) has engaged in or is engaging in any conduct prohibited by K.S.A.  
25 2013 Supp. 21-5426, and amendments thereto, human trafficking or  
26 aggravated human trafficking; or

27 (3) has engaged in or is engaging in any conduct prohibited by K.S.A.  
28 2013 Supp. 21-5703, and amendments thereto, unlawful manufacturing of  
29 controlled substances, or K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 21-5705, and amendments  
30 thereto, unlawful cultivation or distribution of controlled substances.

31 (c) "Documentary material" means any book, paper, document,  
32 writing, drawing, graph, chart, photograph, phonorecord, magnetic tape,  
33 computer printout, other data compilation from which information can be  
34 obtained or from which information can be translated into usable form, or  
35 other tangible item.

36 (d) "Enterprise" means any individual, sole proprietorship,

1 partnership, corporation, business trust, union chartered under the laws of  
2 this state, or other legal entity, or any unchartered union, association, or  
3 group of individuals associated in fact although not a legal entity; and it  
4 includes illicit as well as licit enterprises and governmental, as well as  
5 other, entities. A criminal street gang, as defined in K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 21-  
6 6313, and amendments thereto, constitutes an enterprise.

7 (e) "Pattern of racketeering activity" means engaging in at least two  
8 incidents of racketeering activity that have the same or similar intents,  
9 results, accomplices, victims or methods of commission or that otherwise  
10 are interrelated by distinguishing characteristics and are not isolated  
11 incidents, provided at least one of such incidents occurred after the  
12 effective date of this act and that the last of such incidents occurred within  
13 5 years, excluding any period of imprisonment, after a prior incident of  
14 racketeering activity.

15 (f) "Racketeering activity" means to commit, attempt to commit,  
16 conspire to commit or to solicit, coerce or intimidate another person to  
17 commit:

18 (1) Any felony or misdemeanor violation of: The felony provisions of  
19 K.S.A. 8-1568, and amendments thereto, fleeing or attempting to elude a  
20 police officer; K.S.A. 9-508 et seq., and amendments thereto, Kansas  
21 money transmitter act; article 12a of chapter 17 of the Kansas Statutes  
22 Annotated, and amendments thereto, Kansas uniform securities act; K.S.A.  
23 2013 Supp. 21-5401, and amendments thereto, capital murder; K.S.A.  
24 2013 Supp. 21-5402, and amendments thereto, murder in the first degree;  
25 K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 21-5403, and amendments thereto, murder in the  
26 second degree; K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 21-5408, and amendments thereto,  
27 kidnapping or aggravated kidnapping; K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 21-5412, and  
28 amendments thereto; K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 21-5413, and amendments  
29 thereto; K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 21-5414, and amendments thereto, domestic

28 nonresident pharmacy registration; K.S.A. 65-3441, and amendments  
29 thereto, hazardous waste; K.S.A. 65-4167, and amendments thereto,  
30 trafficking in counterfeit drugs; article 88 of chapter 74 of the Kansas  
31 Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, Kansas parimutuel racing  
32 act; or K.S.A. 79-3321, and amendments thereto, Kansas cigarette and  
33 tobacco products act; or

34 (2) any conduct defined as "racketeering activity" under 18 U.S.C. §  
35 1961(1).

36 (g) "Real property" means any real property or any interest in such  
37 real property, including, but not limited to, any lease of or mortgage upon  
38 such real property.

39 (h) "Trustee" means:

40 (1) Any person acting as trustee pursuant to a trust in which the  
41 trustee holds legal or record title to real property;

42 (2) any person who holds legal or record title to real property in  
43 which any other person has a beneficial interest; or

1 (3) any successor trustee or trustees to any or all of the foregoing  
2 persons.

3 The term "trustee" does not include any person appointed or acting as a  
4 personal representative as defined in K.S.A. 59-102, and amendments  
5 thereto, or appointed or acting as a trustee of any testamentary trust or as a  
6 trustee of any indenture of trust under which any bonds have been or are to  
7 be issued.

8 (i) "Unlawful debt" means any money or other thing of value  
9 constituting principal or interest of a debt that is legally unenforceable in  
10 this state in whole or in part because the debt was incurred or contracted:

11 (1) In violation of any of the following provisions of law: Article 88  
12 of chapter 74 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto,  
13 Kansas parimutuel racing act; K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 21-6404, and  
14 amendments thereto, gambling; K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 21-6405, and  
15 amendments thereto, illegal bingo operation; K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 21-6406,  
16 and amendments thereto, commercial gambling; K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 21-  
17 6407, and amendments thereto, dealing in gambling devices; K.S.A. 2013  
18 Supp. 21-6408, and amendments thereto; or K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 21-6409,  
19 and amendments thereto, installing communication facilities for gamblers;  
20 or

21 (2) in gambling activity in violation of federal law or in the business  
22 of lending money at a rate usurious under state or federal law.

23 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 21-6329 is hereby amended to read as  
24 follows: 21-6329. (a) *Except as provided in subsection (b)*, it is unlawful  
25 for any covered person:

26 (1) Who has ~~with criminal intent~~ received any proceeds derived,  
27 directly or indirectly, from a pattern of racketeering activity or through the  
28 collection of an unlawful debt to use or invest, whether directly or  
29 indirectly, any part of such proceeds, or the proceeds derived from the  
30 investment or use thereof, in the acquisition of any title to, or any right,  
31 interest, or equity in, real property or in the establishment or operation of  
32 any enterprise;

33 (2) through a pattern of racketeering activity or through the collection  
34 of an unlawful debt, to acquire or maintain, directly or indirectly, any  
35 interest in or control of any enterprise or real property; or

36 (3) employed by, or associated with, any enterprise to conduct or  
37 participate, directly or indirectly, in such enterprise through a pattern of  
38 racketeering activity or the collection of an unlawful debt.

39 (b) *It is not unlawful for a covered person to violate subsection (a)*  
40 *through the collection of an unlawful debt if such person was not a*  
41 *participant in a violation described in subsection (i) of K.S.A. 2013 Supp.*  
42 *21-6328, and amendments thereto, which created such unlawful debt.*

43 (c) *The culpable mental state required for a violation of subsection*

1 *(a) is the culpable mental state required for the underlying offense of*  
2 *racketeering activity or unlawful debt, as defined in K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 21-*  
3 *6328, and amendments thereto, and no additional culpable mental state is*  
4 *required for a violation of subsection (a).*

5 ~~(b)~~ *(d)* Violation of this section or conspiracy to commit a violation of  
6 this section is a severity level 2, person felony.

7 ~~(e)~~ *(e)* The provisions of subsection (d) of K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 21-  
8 5302, and amendments thereto, shall not apply to conspiracy to commit a  
9 violation of this section.

10 ~~(d)~~ *(f)* (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 21-  
11 6611, and amendments thereto, any person convicted of engaging in  
12 conduct in violation of this section, through which the person derived  
13 pecuniary value, or by which the person caused personal injury or property  
14 damage or other loss, may be sentenced to pay a fine that does not exceed  
15 three times the gross value gained or three times the gross loss caused,  
16 whichever is the greater, plus court costs and the costs of investigation and  
17 prosecution, reasonably incurred.

18 (2) The court shall hold a hearing to determine the amount of the fine  
19 authorized by this subsection.

20 (3) For the purposes of this subsection, "pecuniary value" means:

21 (A) Anything of value in the form of money, a negotiable instrument,  
22 or a commercial interest or anything else the primary significance of which  
23 is economic advantage; and

24 (B) any other property or service that has a value in excess of \$100.

25 ~~(e)~~ *(g)* For persons arrested and charged under this section, bail shall  
26 be at least \$50,000 cash or surety, unless the court determines on the  
27 record that the defendant is not likely to re-offend, an appropriate intensive  
28 pretrial supervision program is available and the defendant agrees to  
29 comply with the mandate of such pretrial supervision. Notwithstanding  
30 any other provision of law, any person arrested and charged under this  
31 section shall not be released upon the person's own recognizance pursuant  
32 to K.S.A. 22-2802, and amendments thereto.

33 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 21-6328 and 21-6329 are hereby repealed.

34 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
35 publication in the statute book.
