AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 13:3881(A)(4)(c), to enact R.S. 13:3881(A)(4)(g), and to repeal R.S. 13:3881(A)(2)(e), relative to exemptions from seizure; to provide a general exemption from seizure for all firearms and firearm accessories not to exceed a certain value; to repeal the exemption of one firearm of a certain value necessary for the exercise of a trade, calling, or profession; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 13:3881(A)(4)(c) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 13:3881(A)(4)(g) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§3881. General exemptions from seizure

A. The following income or property of a debtor is exempt from seizure under any writ, mandate, or process whatsoever, except as otherwise herein provided:

(4)

(c) His ~~arms and~~ military accoutrements.

1 (g) All firearms, arms and ammunition, and accessories thereto, not
 2 exceeding a total maximum value of two thousand five hundred dollars, which may
 3 be used for any purpose.

5 Section 2. R.S. 13:3881(A)(2)(e) is hereby repealed in its entirety.
