A RESOLUTION

To commend the Scotlandville High School boys' basketball team upon winning the 2015 Class 5A state championship.

WHEREAS, the Scotlandville High School Hornets boys' basketball team completed a sensational season, reclaiming the title of Class 5A state champions by defeating their nemesis from last year's championship game, Natchitoches Central High School, by a score of 42-34, in the state championship game on Friday, March 13, 2015, at Burton Coliseum in Lake Charles, in front of more than eight thousand fans; and

WHEREAS, the game was a tooth-and-nail battle with the Hornets coming from behind to gain the title, and the members of the team performed at the highest level of excellence; each of these Hornets deserves recognition for his vital contribution to the winning effort; and

WHEREAS, also included in Coach Carlos Sample's championship team were junior guard Joshua Roberts, sophomore guard Jalen Hawkins, sophomore forward Lamarq Williams, senior guard Monquel Hawkins, sophomore guard Levi Lewis, senior guard LeMarcus Lee, freshman guard Brenden Vessel, and freshman guard De'Marius Shropshire, and assistant coaches Jeremy Noah and Joshua Washington, and Coach Sample is assured of future contention with the return of many of the fine underclassmen; and
