## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Natural Resources – Hunter Safety Instructors – State Park Entrance Fee**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a person who has been authorized to give a certain course in  
4 conservation and in competency and safety in the handling of firearms to be admitted  
5 to any State park without having to pay an entrance fee; and generally relating to  
6 entrance fees for State parks.

9 Section 5–1011

10 Annotated Code of Maryland

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Natural Resources**

15 **5–1011.**

16 **A PERSON WHO HAS BEEN AUTHORIZED TO GIVE A COURSE OF INSTRUCTION**  
17 **IN CONSERVATION AND IN COMPETENCY AND SAFETY IN THE HANDLING OF**  
18 **FIREARMS UNDER § 10–301.1(B) OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE ADMITTED TO ANY**  
19 **STATE PARK WITHOUT HAVING TO PAY AN ENTRANCE FEE.**

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
21 October 1, 2018.
