- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by deleting the following in lines 341 through 342:- "Failure
- 3 to so notify shall be cause for revocation or suspension of such card."
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 131 of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
- 5 amended by deleting the following in lines 350 through 352:- "Failure to so notify shall be cause
- 6 for revocation or suspension of said license."
