Ehrlich, Cynthia Stone Creem and others for legislation to require the public pension fund to divest from ammunition and firearms; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 4425) of James Arciero, Eileen M. Donoghue and another for legislation to authorize the State Retirement Board to grant creditable service to Paegan Deering, and employee of the Department of Environmental Protection, reports recommending the accompanying order (House, No. 4709) ought to be adopted.

2 General Court to make an investigation and study of House documents numbered 4365, 4402
3 and 4425, relative to retirement and pension matters.

4 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study
5 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
6 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives
7 on or before December 31, 2018.
