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4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING THAT WHEN A PERSON WITH A CONCEALED
5 WEAPON PERMIT MOVES TO A DIFFERENT CITY OR COUNTY, THEY DO NOT HAVE TO NOTIFY LOCAL
6 LAW ENFORCEMENT; AMENDING SECTION 45-8-322, MCA; AND REPEALING SECTION 45-8-325, MCA."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 **Section 1.** Section 45-8-322, MCA, is amended to read:
11 **"45-8-322. Application, renewal, permit, and fees.** (1) The application form must be readily available
12 at the sheriff's office and must read as follows:

16 I, the undersigned applicant, swear that the foregoing information is true and correct to the best of my
 17 knowledge and belief and is given with the full knowledge that any misstatement may be sufficient cause for
 18 denial or revocation of a permit to carry a concealed weapon. I authorize any person having information
 19 concerning me that relates to the information requested by this application and the requirements for a concealed
 20 weapon permit, either public record or otherwise, to furnish it to the sheriff to whom this application is made.

28 (2) The application must be in triplicate. The applicant must be given the original at the time the
 29 completed application is filed with the sheriff, the sheriff shall keep a copy for at least 4 years, and a copy must,



1 within 7 days of the sheriff's receipt of the application, be mailed to the chief of police if the applicant resides in
2 a city or town with a police force.

3 (3) The fee for issuance of a permit is \$50. The permit must be renewed for additional 4-year periods
4 upon payment of a \$25 fee for each renewal and upon request for renewal made within 90 days before expiration
5 of the permit. The permit and each renewal must be in triplicate, in a form prescribed by the department of justice,
6 and must, at a minimum, include the name, address, physical description, signature, driver's license number,
7 state identification card number, or tribal identification card number, and a picture of the permittee. A person in
8 the United States armed forces satisfies the requirement of submitting a picture if the person submits pictures
9 of the front of the person's military identification card and the person's Montana driver's license. The permit must
10 state that federal and state laws on possession of firearms and other weapons differ and that a person who
11 violates the federal law may be prosecuted in federal court and the Montana permit will not be a defense. The
12 permittee must be given the original, and the sheriff shall keep a copy and send a copy to the department of
13 justice, which shall keep a central repository record of all permits. Replacement of a lost permit must be treated
14 as a renewal under this subsection.

15 (4) The sheriff shall conduct a background check of an applicant to determine whether the applicant is
16 eligible for a permit under 45-8-321, may require an applicant to submit the applicant's fingerprints, and may
17 charge the applicant \$5 for fingerprinting. A renewal does not require repeat fingerprinting.

18 (5) Permit, background, and fingerprinting fees may be retained by the sheriff and used to implement
19 45-8-321 through ~~45-8-325~~ 45-8-324.

20 (6) A state or local government law enforcement agency or other agency or any of its officers or
21 employees may not request a permittee to voluntarily submit information in addition to that required on an
22 application and permit.

23 (7) All of the information on the application is confidential, and the sheriff shall treat the confidential
24 information on the application as confidential criminal justice information pursuant to Title 44, chapter 5."

26 **NEW SECTION. Section 2. Repealer.** The following section of the Montana Code Annotated is
27 repealed:

28 45-8-325. Permittee change of county of residence -- notification to sheriffs and chief of police.
