- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to agriculture; to amend sections 2-2301, 2-2304, 2-3601, 2-3611, 2-3612, 2-3615, 2-3627, 2-3629, 2-3634, 2-3635, 2-3735, 2-3745, 2-3746, and 2-3747, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide for redesignation of districts of members of various commodities boards or commissions as prescribed; to provide for changing the number of at-large members; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original sections.
- 8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 2-2301, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 2-2301 Sections 2-2301 to 2-2321 and section 3 of this act shall be
- 4 known and may be cited as the Nebraska Wheat Resources Act.
- 5 Sec. 2. Section 2-2304, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 6 amended to read:
- 7 2-2304 Except as provided in section 3 of this act:
- 8 (1) The board shall be composed of seven members who shall (a) be
- 9 citizens of Nebraska, (b) be at least twenty-one years of age, (c) have
- 10 been actually engaged in growing wheat in this state for a period of at
- 11 least five years, and (d) derive a substantial portion of their income
- 12 from growing wheat. The Director of Agriculture and the vice chancellor
- 13 of the University of Nebraska Institute of Agriculture and Natural
- 14 Resources shall serve as nonvoting members of the board. With the
- 15 exception of the nonvoting members, the Governor shall appoint the
- 16 members to the board; and -
- 17 (2) The seven appointed members shall be appointed from the
- 18 following districts:
- 19 (a) District 1: The counties of Sioux, Scotts Bluff, Dawes, Box
- 20 Butte, Morrill, Sheridan, and Garden;
- 21 (b) District 2: The counties of Kimball, Banner, and Cheyenne;
- (c) District 3: The counties of Perkins, Deuel, Keith, Arthur,
- 23 McPherson, Logan, Grant, Hooker, Thomas, and Cherry;
- 24 (d) District 4: The counties of Lincoln, Chase, Dundy, Hayes,
- 25 Hitchcock, and Frontier;
- 26 (e) District 5: The counties of Buffalo, Dawson, Phelps, Custer,
- 27 Gosper, Kearney, Red Willow, Furnas, Harlan, and Franklin;
- 28 (f) District 6: The counties of Adams, Webster, Nuckolls, Thayer,
- 29 Jefferson, Gage, Johnson, Nemaha, Pawnee, Richardson, Otoe, Cass,
- 30 Lancaster, Seward, York, Hamilton, Hall, Sherman, Howard, Merrick, Nance,
- 31 Polk, Butler, Saunders, Sarpy, Douglas, Washington, Dodge, Colfax,

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- 1 Platte, Burt, Cuming, Stanton, Madison, Boone, Valley, Greeley, Antelope,

- 5 (g) District 7: The at-large district.
- 6 Sec. 3. The board shall be responsible for the administration of
- 7 all subsequent appointments for membership on the board and may adopt
- 8 <u>rules and regulations to carry out such responsibility. The composition</u>
- 9 of the board as defined by section 2-2304 shall continue until such time
- 10 as the board determines that the districts and at-large membership as
- 11 <u>defined by such section are incompatible with an equitable representation</u>
- 12 of producers of wheat due to changing geographic distribution of wheat
- 13 production in the state, changing marketing patterns, or availability of
- 14 qualified individuals to serve as board members. The board may, from time
- 15 to time as appropriate, by rule and regulation, redesignate districts and
- 16 <u>the number of at-large members to provide for an equitable representation</u>
- 17 of producers of wheat.
- 18 Sec. 4. Section 2-3601, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 19 amended to read:
- 20 2-3601 Sections 2-3601 to 2-3635 <u>and section 12 of this act</u>shall be
- 21 known and may be cited as the Nebraska Corn Resources Act.
- 22 Sec. 5. Section 2-3611, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 23 amended to read:
- 24 2-3611 The board shall be composed of nine members who (1) are
- 25 citizens of Nebraska, (2) are at least twenty-one years of age, (3) have
- 26 been actually engaged in growing corn in this state for a period of at
- 27 least five years, and (4) derive a substantial portion of their income
- 28 from growing corn.
- 29 The Director of Agriculture, the vice chancellor of the University
- 30 of Nebraska Institute of Agriculture and Natural Resources, and the
- 31 president of the Nebraska Corn Growers Association shall be ex officio

- 1 members of the board but shall have no vote in board matters.
- 2 Sec. 6. Section 2-3612, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 4 2-3612 Except for the position of the at-large members member,
- 5 whenever a vacancy occurs on the board for any reason, the Governor shall
- 6 appoint an individual to fill such vacancy from the district in which the
- 7 vacancy exists. If the vacant position is that of an the at-large member,
- 8 the appointment to fill such vacancy shall be made at large by the board.

- 2-3615 Except as provided in section 12 of this act, one One member
- shall be appointed from each of the following districts:

- 14 Seward, Lancaster, Cass, Otoe, Saline, Jefferson, Gage, Johnson, Nemaha,
- 15 Pawnee, and Richardson;
- 16 (b) District 2. The counties of Adams, Clay, Fillmore, Franklin,
- 17 Webster, Nuckolls, and Thayer;
- 18 (c) District 3. The counties of Merrick, Polk, Hamilton, and York;
- 19 (d) District 4. The counties of Knox, Cedar, Dixon, Dakota, Pierce,
- 20 Wayne, Thurston, Madison, Stanton, Cuming, Burt, Colfax, Dodge, and
- 21 Washington;
- (e) District 5. The counties of Sherman, Howard, Dawson, Buffalo,
- 23 and Hall;

- 25 Kearney, Hitchcock, Red Willow, Furnas, and Harlan;
- 26 (g) District 7. The counties of Boyd, Holt, Antelope, Garfield,
- 27 Wheeler, Boone, Platte, Valley, Greeley, and Nance; and
- 28 (h) District 8. The counties of Sioux, Dawes, Box Butte, Sheridan,
- 29 Scotts Bluff, Banner, Kimball, Morrill, Cheyenne, Garden, Deuel, Cherry,

- 7 out the intent and purposes of the Nebraska Corn Resources Act sections
- 8 2-3601 to 2-3635, reduce such fees for such period as it shall deem
- 9 justified, but not less than one year. If the board, after reducing such
- 10 fees finds that sufficient revenue is not being produced by such reduced

- 5 defined by such section are incompatible with an equitable representation
- 6 of producers of corn due to changing geographic distribution of corn
- 7 production in the state, changing marketing patterns, or availability of
- 8 qualified individuals to serve as board members. The board may, from time
- 9 to time as appropriate, by rule and regulation, redesignate districts and
- 10 the number of at-large members to provide for an equitable representation
- 11 of producers of corn.
- 12 Sec. 13. Section 2-3735, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 15 known and may be cited as the Dry Bean Resources Act.
- 16 Sec. 14. Section 2-3745, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 18 2-3745 The There is hereby created the Dry Bean Commission is
- 19 created. Except as provided in section 17 of this act, the commission
- 20 which shall be composed of nine members, two of whom shall be selected by
- 21 the commission and seven of whom shall be appointed by the Governor.
- 22 Commission members shall be appointed on a nonpartisan basis. Six members
- 23 shall be growers who (1) are citizens of Nebraska, (2) are at least
- 24 twenty-one years of age, (3) have actually been engaged in growing dry
- 25 beans in this state for at least three years, and (4) derive a
- 26 substantial portion of their income from growing dry beans. Three members
- 27 shall be dry bean processors who have been in business in Nebraska for at
- 28 least three years, and the Director of the University of Nebraska
- 29 Panhandle Research and Extension Center shall be an ex officio member but
- 30 shall have no vote in commission matters.

- 2 2-3746 Except as provided in section 17 of this act:
- 3 (1) The Governor shall appoint one grower member from each of the
- 4 following four districts:
- 5 (a) District 1 which shall consist of the counties of Sioux, Dawes,
- 6 Sheridan, and Box Butte;
- 7 (b) District 2 which shall consist of the county of Scotts Bluff;
- 8 (c) District 3 which shall consist of the counties of Banner,
- 9 Morrill, Kimball, Cheyenne, Garden, and Deuel; and
- 10 (d) District 4 which shall consist of the remaining counties in
- 11 which dry bean production occurs in the state; -
- 12 (2) The commission shall appoint two grower members to the
- 13 commission, one of whom resides within district 1 or 2 who shall
- 14 represent districts 1 and 2 and one of whom resides within district 3 or
- 15 4 who shall represent districts 3 and 4. Members serving as
- 16 representatives of such districts on May 18, 2011, shall continue as
- 17 members of the commission until the end of their terms and until their

- 20 (3) The three processor members of the commission shall be appointed
- 21 by the Governor. Insofar as possible, the geographic locations of such
- 22 appointed members shall be representative of the Nebraska dry bean
- 23 industry. Any processor may place his or her name on a candidacy list for
- 24 appointment by written notice to the commission.

- 30 resident bean growers (1) from the district in which he or she resides
- 31 for an appointment under <u>subdivision</u> subsection (1) of section 2-3746 or

- 1 (2) from the district in which he or she resides or the other district to
- 2 be represented for an appointment under <u>subdivision</u> subsection (2) of
- 3 section 2-3746. The petition shall be filed with the commission. The
- 4 Governor and the commission shall make appointments from the candidacy
- 5 list unless there are no names on the list.
- 6 Sec. 17. The commission shall be responsible for the administration
- 7 of all subsequent appointments for membership on the commission and may
- 8 adopt rules and regulations to carry out such responsibility. The
- 9 composition of the commission as defined by section 2-3746 shall continue
- 10 until such time as the commission determines that the districts and at-
- 11 <u>large membership as defined by such section are incompatible with an</u>
- 12 equitable representation of producers of dry beans due to changing
- 13 geographic distribution of dry bean production in the state, changing
- 14 marketing patterns, or availability of qualified individuals to serve as
- commission members. The commission may, from time to time as appropriate,
- 16 by rule and regulation, redesignate districts and the number of at-large
- 17 members to provide for an equitable representation of producers of dry
- 18 beans.
