14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1290.6, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 1290.6.
18	PROHIBITED AMMUNITION
19	Any concealed or unconcealed handgun when carried in a manner
20	authorized by the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act and
21	when loaded with any ammunition which is either a restricted bullet
22	as defined by Section 1289.19 of this title or is larger than .45
23	caliber or is otherwise prohibited by law shall be deemed a
24	prohibited weapon for purposes of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act.

1	Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be
2	punished for a criminal offense as provided by Section 1272 of this
3	title or any other applicable provision of law. In addition to any
4	criminal prosecution for a violation of the provisions of this
5	section, the licensee shall be subject to an administrative fine of
6	Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), upon a hearing and determination by
7	the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation that the person is in
8	violation of the provisions of this section.
9	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
