14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
16	last amended by Section 3, Chapter 372, O.S.L. 2014 (47 O.S. Supp.
17	2014, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:
18	Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
19	authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
20	plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
21	financial assistance as provided by this section.
22	Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
23	person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
24	ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used

1 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been 2 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

3 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax 4 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall 5 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain 6 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor 7 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be 8 9 issued on a staggered system.

10 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 11 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept 12 applications for special license plates authorized under this 13 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's 14 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 15 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 16 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 17 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 18 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 19 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for 20 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 21 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

22 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates 23 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1, 24 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of HB1299 HFLR Page 2

1 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special 2 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license 3 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be 4 5 removed from the vehicle.

For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, 6 7 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid 8 9 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by 10 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the 11 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall 12 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are 13 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time 14 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

15 The special license plates provided by this section are as в. 16 follows:

17 1. University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates 18 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 19 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As 20 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be 21 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

22 2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall 23 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax 24 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in HB1299 HFLR

1 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any 2 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide 3 general public environmental education program created pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. 4 Such 5 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for 6 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued 7 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated 8 9 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee 10 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by 11 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in 12 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned 13 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

14 3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed 15 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid. 16 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four 17 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a 18 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an 19 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department. 20 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of 21 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to 22 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any 23 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may 24 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated HB1299 HFLR

1 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon 2 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire 3 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief 4 of the fire department.

5 Except for motorcycles, the license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" in the color Pantone 186C Red and shall contain no more 6 7 than three letters and three numbers in the color Pantone 301C Blue. Between the letters and numbers shall be the Firefighter Maltese 8 9 Cross Logo in the color Pantone 186C Red outlined in the color 10 Pantone 301C Blue. Below the letters and the logo shall be the word 11 "Firefighter" in the color Pantone 186C Red. The license plate for 12 motorcycles may be of a similar design as space permits or a new 13 design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle 14 license plate. The plates shall not be subject to the design 15 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other 16 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each 17 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue.

18 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected 19 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building & 20 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and 21 Living Memorial;

22 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be 23 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax 24 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in HB1299 HFLR Page 5

1 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any 2 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in 3 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may 4 5 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license 6 plates.

7 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of 8 9 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

10 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be 11 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax 12 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State 13 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child 14 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for 15 the prevention of child abuse.

16 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected 17 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

18 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates -19 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to 20 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The 21 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers 22 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized 23 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States 24 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if HB1299 HFLR

necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate issued;

7 7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
9 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
10 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
11 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

12 8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be 13 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother 14 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected 15 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving 16 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton, 17 Oklahoma;

9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates 2 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency 3 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical 4 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying 5 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in 6 7 consultation with the state association of emergency medical technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee 8 9 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Technician 10 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

12 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be 13 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of 14 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount 15 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act 16 Revolving Fund;

17 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
18 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
19 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
20 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
21 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
22 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
23 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use

1 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to 2 provide services to crime victims;

3 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates 4 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. 5 The license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma 6 7 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -8 9 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to 10 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

11 14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed, 12 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the 13 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 14 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued 15 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in 16 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to 17 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in 18 Section 1104.4 of this title;

19 Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall 15. 20 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax 21 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and 22 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued 23 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag 24 in the Classroom Education Program. 1 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in 2 Section 1104.3 of this title;

3 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates 4 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate 5 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma 6 7 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be 8 9 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial 10 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of 11 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

12 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be 13 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission 14 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the 15 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to 16 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate 17 18 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three 19 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as 20 follows:

- a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
 Reform Revolving Fund,
- b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
 Education Revolving Fund,

- 1 five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State с. 2 Career Technology Fund, and
- 3 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be 4 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as 5 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes. 6

7 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial 8 9 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be 10 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this 11 paragraph;

12 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plates -13 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of 14 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the 15 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the 16 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as 17 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate 18 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in 19 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or 20 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown. 21 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of 22 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to 23 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any 24 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the HB1299 HFLR

1 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is 2 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired 3 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the 4 5 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such 6 7 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall 8 9 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters 10 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo. 11 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into 12 13 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any 14 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts 15 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide 16 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty 17 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

18 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such 19 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the 20 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and 21 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state 22 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and 23 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 24 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of HB1299 HFLR

1 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
2 of this title;

3 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates 4 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax 5 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma 6 7 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation 8 9 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and 10 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

11 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates 12 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of 13 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for 14 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive 15 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and 16 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates 17 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation 18 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human 19 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall Services. 20 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury 21 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the 22 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act 23 specifically for created families;

Color Oklahoma License Plates - such plates shall be 4 5 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission 6 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person 7 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's 8 9 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section, 10 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.8 of this title; 11

12 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter 13 License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any 14 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the 15 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person 16 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of 17 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain 18 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The 19 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a 20 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of 21 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use 22 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design.
