WHEREAS, during those years, Ms. Vrana assumed a large role in the enactment of the Ad Valorem Reform laws in the 1980s and was the first Assessor to graduate from the mandatory educational curriculum; and

WHEREAS, after retiring from county government, Ms. Vrana became a licensed abstractor working for Creek County Abstract and Title Company, prior to marrying her late husband, Chuck Vrana and moving to Shawnee, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Vrana is blessed with two children, Steven B. Jones and Veronica White and two grandchildren, Tyler and Mallory. All reside in the Sapulpa area where they were born and raised; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Vrana's journey in Elkdom began in the Sand Springs
Lodge where she served as Exalted Ruler. She additionally served
the Grand Lodge in the capacity of District Deputy to the Grand
Exalted Ruler as well as being elected Northeast District VicePresident; and
