5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to firearms; allowing certain law
7 enforcement agency employees to carry a firearm in
8 the scope of employment; providing for codification;
and providing an effective date.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1289.31 of Title 21, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 Any law enforcement agency which employs noncommissioned
15 civilian crime scene technicians or crime scene investigators may
16 authorize such employees who have a valid Oklahoma concealed carry
17 handgun permit, to carry such licensed weapon while acting in the
18 scope of their employment. The director of the employing agency
19 must grant written authorization, which the noncommissioned
20 technician or investigator must keep on his or her person at all
21 times while carrying the weapon, along with the appropriate valid
22 concealed carry permit and photo identification.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
