For purposes of this section, qualifying renewable energy resources shall include: 4 5 1. Wind; 2. Solar; 6 3. Photovoltaic; 7 4. Hydropower; 8 9 5. Hydrogen; 10 6. Geothermal; Biomass, which projects may include agricultural crops, 11 7. wastes, and residues, wood, animal and other degradable organic 12 13 wastes, municipal solid waste, and landfill gas; 8. Distributed generation from an eligible renewable energy 14 resource where the generating facility or any integrated cluster of 15 such facilities has an installed generating capacity of not more 16 17 than five (5) megawatts; 9. Other renewable sources approved by the Commission; and 18 10. Demand side management and energy efficiency as provided in 19 Section 6 of this act. 20 Steam export capacity at a qualified renewable energy 21 Ε. resource shall count toward the goal established in subsection C of 22 23 this section. 24

1	F. The annual renewable energy percentage shall be determined
2	by dividing all installed capacity of renewable electricity
3	generation in Oklahoma by the total installed capacity of all
4	electricity generation in Oklahoma. Every electricity generating
5	entity or company operating electricity generation facilities in
6	Oklahoma shall report to the Commission by March 1 each year the
7	installed capacity of each of its generating facilities, the number
8	of kilowatt hours generated by each facility in Oklahoma and from
9	which source of energy the electricity was produced.
10	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
11	of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
12	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
