6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to firearms; amending 21 O.S. 2011,  
8 Section 1289.6, as amended by Section 11, Chapter  
9 259, O.S.L. 2012 (21 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section  
10 1289.6), which relates to conditions under which  
11 firearms may be carried; adding condition; and  
12 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1289.6, as  
15 amended by Section 11, Chapter 259, O.S.L. 2012 (21 O.S. Supp. 2014,  
16 Section 1289.6), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1289.6.

17 CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH FIREARMS MAY BE CARRIED

18 A. A ~~person~~ citizen shall be permitted to carry loaded and  
19 unloaded shotguns, rifles and pistols, open and not concealed and  
20 without a handgun license as authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense  
21 Act pursuant to the following conditions:

22 1. When hunting animals or fowl;

1        2. During competition in or practicing in a safety or hunter  
2 safety class, target shooting, skeet, trap or other recognized  
3 sporting events;

4        3. During participation in or in preparation for a military  
5 function of the state military forces to be defined as the Oklahoma  
6 Army or Air National Guard, Federal Military Reserve and active  
7 military forces;

8        4. During participation in or in preparation for a recognized  
9 police function of either a municipal, county or state government as  
10 functioning police officials;

11       5. During a practice for or a performance for entertainment  
12 purposes;

13       6. For lawful self-defense and self-protection or any other  
14 legitimate purpose in or on property that is owned, leased, rented,  
15 or otherwise legally controlled by the person; ~~or~~

16       7. When carried in a holster that is wholly or partially  
17 visible or in a scabbard, case or with a sling designed for carrying  
18 firearms that is wholly or partially visible and the person is  
19 twenty-one (21) years of age or older. Any person who carries a  
20 firearm in the manner provided for in this paragraph shall be  
21 prohibited from carrying the firearm into any of the places as  
22 prescribed in subsection A of Section 1277 of this title; or

1       8. For any legitimate purpose not in violation of the Oklahoma  
2 Firearms Act of 1971 or any legislative enactment regarding the use,  
3 ownership and control of firearms.

4       B. A person shall be permitted to carry unloaded shotguns,  
5 rifles and pistols, open and not concealed and without a handgun  
6 license as authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act pursuant to  
7 the following conditions:

8       1. When going to or from the person's private residence or  
9 vehicle or a vehicle in which the person is riding as a passenger to  
10 a place designated or authorized for firearms repairs or  
11 reconditioning, or for firearms trade, sale, or barter, or gunsmith,  
12 or hunting animals or fowl, or hunter safety course, or target  
13 shooting, or skeet or trap shooting or any recognized firearms  
14 activity or event and while in such places; or

15       2. For any legitimate purpose not in violation of the Oklahoma  
16 Firearms Act of 1971.

17       C. The provisions of this section shall not be construed to  
18 prohibit educational or recreational activities, exhibitions,  
19 displays or shows involving the use or display of rifles, shotguns  
20 or pistols or other weapons if the activity is approved by the  
21 property owner and sponsor of the activity.

22       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
