13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 150.23, as
15	last amended by Section 45, Chapter 210, O.S.L. 2016 (74 O.S. Supp.
16	2017, Section 150.23), is amended to read as follows:
17	Section 150.23. A. An officer, investigator, or agent of the
18	Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, the Oklahoma State Bureau of
19	Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, the Department of Wildlife
20	Conservation, the Law Enforcement Division of the Oklahoma Horse
21	Racing Commission, the State Fire Marshal's Office, the Oklahoma
22	Tourism and Recreation Department, the Office of Inspector General
23	and the Oklahoma Child Support Services divisions of the Department
24	of Human Services, a Probation and Parole officer or Internal

- Affairs agent of the Department of Corrections, law enforcement
 officers employed by the Grand River Dam Authority or the office of
 a district attorney shall be entitled to receive, upon retirement by
 reason of length of service, the continued custody and possession of
 the sidearm and badge carried by such officer, investigator, or
 agent immediately prior to retirement.
 - B. An officer, investigator, or agent specified in subsection A of this section may be entitled to receive, upon retirement by reason of disability, the continued custody and possession of the sidearm and badge carried by such officer or agent immediately prior to retirement upon written approval of the applicable Director of the appropriate Bureau, Department, Commission, or district attorney.
 - C. Custody and possession of the sidearm and badge of an officer, investigator, or agent who dies while employed by any Bureau, Department, Commission, or office specified in subsection A of this section may be awarded by the applicable Director of the appropriate Bureau, Department, Commission, or office to the spouse or next of kin of the deceased officer, investigator, or agent.
 - D. A correctional officer of the Oklahoma Department of Corrections shall be entitled to receive, upon retirement by reason of length of service, the continued custody and possession of the firearm and badge carried by such officer immediately prior to retirement.

1	E. In addition to the firearm carried by a correctional officer
2	of the Department of Corrections, the retired correctional officer
3	may purchase the rifle or shotgun, or both, issued to the
4	correctional officer immediately prior to retirement. The cost to
5	the retired agent of purchasing the rifle or shotgun, or both, shall
6	be the price the Department of Corrections paid at the time of
7	purchase, and upon payment of that price, the retired correctional
8	officer shall be entitled to ownership of the rifle or shotgun, or
9	both.
10	$\overline{ ext{F.}}$ In addition to the sidearm carried by a retired agent of the
11	Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, the retired agent may
12	purchase the rifle or shotgun, or both, issued to the retired agent
13	immediately prior to retirement. The cost to the retired agent of
14	purchasing the rifle or shotgun, or both, shall be the price the
15	Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation paid at the time of purchase,
16	and upon payment of that price, the retired agent shall be entitled
17	to ownership of the rifle or shotgun, or both.
18	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
