10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11                   SECTION 1.            AMENDATORY            Section 19, Chapter 364, O.S.L.  
12 2017 (37A O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 3-116.2), is amended to read as  
13 follows:

14           Section 3-116.2.   A.   In the event a manufacturer has designated  
15 ~~a one or more~~ wine and spirits ~~wholesaler~~ wholesalers to sell its  
16 product in the state, the designated wine and spirits wholesaler  
17 shall comply with the following posting requirements: The wine and  
18 spirits wholesaler shall submit its line-item price posting for that  
19 product no later than the fifteenth day of each month. If the  
20 fifteenth day of the month falls on a Saturday, Sunday or a holiday  
21 then the wine and spirits wholesaler shall submit its price posting  
22 on the next business day. The price posting submitted by the wine  
23 and spirits wholesaler shall list the line-item price, handling  
24 cost, transportation cost and any other costs that may be associated

1 with the sale or delivery of that item. All prices shall become  
2 effective on the first business day of the month following posting  
3 and shall remain in effect and unchanged in one-month increments.  
4 No change or modification of the posted price shall be permitted  
5 except upon written permission from the ABLE Commission based on  
6 good cause shown.

7 B. This section shall not apply unless a product has been  
8 designated by a manufacturer for distribution by ~~a single~~ one or  
9 more designated wine and spirits ~~wholesaler~~ wholesalers in the  
10 state.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
