6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending
8 21 O.S. 2021 Section 1289.17A, which relates to the
9 unlawful discharge of firearms and deadly weapons;
10 updating language; clarifying meaning of specific
11 term; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1289.17A, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1289.17A

16 FELONY DISCHARGING FIREARMS

17 A. It shall be unlawful for any person to willfully or
18 intentionally discharge any firearm or other deadly weapon at or
19 into any dwelling, or at or into any building used for public or
20 business purposes.

21 B. Any ~~violation of~~ person convicted of violating the
22 provisions of this section shall be guilty of a felony punishable by
23 imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a
24 term not less than two (2) years nor more than twenty (20) years.

1 C. The provisions of this section shall not apply to any law
2 enforcement officer in the performance of any lawful duty.

3 D. As used in this section, the term "deadly weapon" shall
4 include, but not be limited to, crossbows and compound bows.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
