11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-148.1 of Title 70, unless
14	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	A. Except as provided for in subsection B of this section, by
16	July 1, 2026, each school district in this state shall undergo a
17	risk and vulnerability assessment conducted by the Oklahoma School
18	Security Institute. The assessment shall include recommendations to
19	increase security on school district property.
20	B. A school district that underwent a risk and vulnerability
21	assessment conducted by the Oklahoma School Security Institute in
22	the two (2) years prior to the effective date of this act shall be
23	exempt from the provisions of subsection A of this section.

1	C. After an initial risk and vulnerability assessment is
2	conducted, school districts shall coordinate with the Oklahoma
3	School Security Institute to conduct re-assessments every five (5)
4	years.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
6	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7	of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby
8	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
