AN ACT

Section 6111.1(f)(2) of Title 18 of the 6 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 8 § 6111.1. Pennsylvania State Police. * * * 9 10 (f) Notification of mental health adjudication, treatment, 11 commitment, drug use or addiction .--* * * 12 13 The notification shall be transmitted by the judge 14 to the Pennsylvania State Police [within seven days of] 15 between 72 and 96 hours after the adjudication, commitment or 16 treatment. 17

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
