HOUSE BILL 1821

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39,
relative to weapons.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39, Chapter 17, Part 13, is amended by adding the following new section:

Notwithstanding another law to the contrary, in consideration that the right to keep and bear arms is protected and reserved to the people in Article I, § 26, of the Constitution of Tennessee, a person who has not been convicted of a violent, felony crime and who is lawfully able to own or to possess a firearm under the Constitution of Tennessee is considered to be individually licensed and verified by this state within the meaning of the provisions regarding individual licensure and verification in the federal Gun-Free School Zones Act.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
