RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2403) to amend chapter 44 of title 18, United States Code, to strengthen the background check procedures to be followed before a Federal firearms licensee may transfer a firearm to a person who is not such a licensee.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-
2 olution, the House shall proceed to the consideration in
3 the House of the bill (H.R. 2403) to amend chapter 44
4 of title 18, United States Code, to strengthen the back-
5 ground check procedures to be followed before a Federal
6 firearms licensee may transfer a firearm to a person who
7 is not such a licensee. All points of order against consider-

1 ation of the bill are waived. The bill shall be considered
2 as read. All points of order against provisions in the bill
3 are waived. The previous question shall be considered as
4 ordered on the bill and on any amendment thereto to final
5 passage without intervening motion except: (1) one hour
6 of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and
7 ranking minority member of the Committee on the Judici-
8 ary or their respective designees; and (2) one motion to
9 recommit.

10 SEC. 2. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX shall not apply to
11 the consideration of H.R. 2403.
