A BILL

To amend chapter 44 of title 18, United States Code, to prohibit the sale or other disposition of a firearm to, and the possession, shipment, transportation, or receipt of a firearm by, certain classes of high-risk individuals.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Keeping Guns from
5 High-Risk Individuals Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. FIREARM PROHIBITIONS APPLICABLE WITH RE-**
2 **SPECT TO CERTAIN HIGH-RISK INDIVIDUALS.**

3 (a) SALES OR OTHER DISPOSITIONS.—Section
4 922(d) of title 18, United States Code, is amended—

5 (1) in paragraph (10), by striking “or” at the
6 end;

7 (2) in paragraph (11), by striking the period at
8 the end and inserting a semicolon; and

9 (3) by adding at the end the following:

10 “(12) in the most recent 5-year period, has
11 been convicted in any court of a crime of violence
12 (as defined in section 16);

13 “(13) has not attained 25 years of age, and has
14 been adjudicated by any court as having committed
15 an offense that would have been a crime of violence
16 (as defined in section 16) if committed by an adult;
17 or

18 “(14) has been convicted in any court of stalk-
19 ing.”.

20 (b) POSSESSION, SHIPMENT, TRANSPORTATION, OR
21 RECEIPT.—Section 922(g) of such title is amended—

22 (1) in paragraph (8)(C)(ii), by striking “or” at
23 the end;

24 (2) in paragraph (9), by striking the comma at
25 the end and inserting a semicolon; and

1 (3) by inserting after paragraph (9) the fol-
2 lowing:

3 “(10) who, in the most recent 5-year period,
4 has been convicted in any court of a crime of vio-
5 lence (as defined in section 16); or

6 “(11) who has been convicted in any court of
7 stalking,”.
