17-50-304, as renumbered and amended by Laws of Utah 2000, Chapter 133

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **17-50-304** is amended to read:

17-50-304. Police, building, sanitary, and dangerous materials regulations.

~~[A county may make and enforce within]~~ Within the limits of the county[;] and outside



28 the limits of cities and towns, each county:

29 (1) may make and enforce all such local, police, building, and sanitary regulations as
30 are not in conflict with general laws[-]; and

31 (2) of the first or second class may regulate and prevent the discharge of firearms,
32 rockets, powder, fireworks in accordance with Section [53-7-225](#), or any other dangerous or
33 combustible material.
