53-5a-109. Possession of an altered toy, look-alike, or imitation firearm by a minor.

- 24 (1) As used in this section:
 - (a) "Altered toy, look-alike, or imitation firearm" means a toy, look-alike, or imitation firearm that has been altered so that a reasonable person would believe that the toy, look-alike, or imitation firearm is an actual firearm.
 - (b) "Minor" means an individual younger than 18 years old.
- 29 (c) "Public place" means the same as that term is defined in Section 76-9-102.
- (d) "Toy, look-alike, or imitation firearm" means a non-firearm device regulated under 30

32	(2) It is an infraction for a minor to possess an altered toy, look-alike, or imitation firearm if
33	the minor:
34	(a) intentionally or knowingly possesses the altered toy, look-alike, or imitation firearm
35	in a public place;
36	(b) knows the possessed toy, look-alike, or imitation firearm is an altered toy, look-alike
37	or imitation firearm; and
38	(c) has previously received a documented warning from a law enforcement officer
39	warning the minor that it is unlawful for the minor to possess an altered toy,
40	look-alike, or imitation firearm in a public place.
41	Section 2. Effective Date.
42	This bill takes effect on May 6, 2026.
